WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY

French-born Winemaker Christophe "Cris" Legrandjacques draws inspiration for Cardiff wines from the European approach to quality and attention to detail, while at the same time embracing innovation and inventiveness. Taking a classic approach with Cardiff wines, he seeks to harmonize the grapes' rich fruit flavors with elegance and finesse. Cris selects only the best grapes, crafting Cardiff wines to be flavorful and well-balanced.

WINEMAKING

After harvest, the grapes are gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel under temperature-controlled conditions to preserve the crispness and ripe fruit flavors. The wine is then aged in American oak, and gently filtered and fined prior to bottling.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Cardiff Cabernet Sauvignon, with flavors of blackberry, plum, allspice and vanilla, is an ideal match with roast prime rib or braised lamb shanks.
