WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY

French-born Winemaker Christophe "Cris" Legrandjacques draws inspiration for Cardiff wines from the European approach to quality and attention to detail, while at the same time embracing innovation and inventiveness. Taking a classic approach with Cardiff wines, he seeks to harmonize the grapes' rich fruit flavors with elegance and finesse. Cris selects only the best grapes, crafting Cardiff wines to be flavorful and well-balanced.

WINEMAKING

After harvest, the grapes were gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel under temperature-controlled conditions to preserve the crispness and ripe fruit flavors. The wine then went through a secondary malolactic fermentation for creaminess, followed by oak aging sur lie, adding toastiness and complexity. The wine was gently filtered and fined prior to bottling.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Cardiff cellars Chardonnay shines with tropical and citrus fruit flavors against a backdrop of toasty vanilla. Serve with grilled Coho salmon or mussels simmered in white wine and garlic.
